The Art on a Rain Barrel Design contest is open to any adult or child willing to exercise their creativity on behalf of water conservation and stewardship. Registration forms and a sketch of your proposed design must be submitted by **June 30, 2010 in order for your design to be considered for the contest**. Completed registration forms and sketches must be submitted electronically by email to fmc@manayunkcanal.org. Design sketches will be judged by our expert panelists by July 16th to choose the top designs to be included in the contest. Artists will be notified if their design is selected by the Judges by July 16th and rain barrel distribution will begin on July 19th. Artists will have until August 20, 2010 to complete their designs and return the rain barrels for judging. Artists are expected to be present at the EcoArts Festival on September 26, 2010 on Main Street in Manayunk for the announcement of the winners. Artists whose sketches are chosen to participate in the contest will receive a plain rain barrel to keep. Winners, in addition to receiving a rain barrel will also win a prize basket.

Participant Requirements- Please respond to the below questions to be sure you are agreeable to the terms for participation in the Art on a Rain Barrel Design Contest.

Will you be able to attend the EcoArts Festival on Sunday, September 26, 2010 for the award presentation?

Are you willing to provide a fully refundable \$50 deposit to FMC upon receipt of your rain barrel to paint? **Note: The deposit is simply to insure that the rain barrels will be returned to FMC for use in the contest. The deposit will be returned in full to each participant no later than August 20, 2010, when the artists submit their completed barrels for judging. All completed barrels will be displayed during the month of September during judging.**

Are you willing to provide all paint and supplies you will need to complete your rain barrel design? **Note: Whatever materials you use need to be weather resistant as the barrels will be installed outdoors.**

Are you able to make arrangements to pick up and transport your rain barrel to and from Manayunk to a site of your choosing at the beginning (July 19) and end (August 20) of the design phase?

Do you give FMC permission to keep and use your designed rain barrel and any pictures taken during the event and/or of your design for promotional purposes?

Have you attached a sketch of your proposed rain barrel design? If not, you need to submit one prior to June 30th in order for your design to be considered for the contest.
